THE ROLE

Working under a revenue share license agreement on a parttime roster, the physicians will be expected to provide high quality clinical assessment, management, and consultation to patients at MQ Health Pre-Admission Clinic both in-person and via telemedicine (Monday-Friday), and to support inpatients requiring medical management throughout their stay at Macquarie University Hospital (Monday-Sunday), including in partnership with the WiSE Clinic.

Essential crietria includes:

- 1. Fellowship of Royal Australasian College of Physicians or equivalent
- 2. Participation in on-call roster for admissions from emergency referral affiliates on Saturday & Sunday.

The physicians will also be expected to facilitate the teaching and training of students during clinical placements and engage in quality assurance activities at MQ Health. Opportunities to engage in clinical and/or laboratory research and more formal teaching are available to be explored through an appointment with the Faculty of Medicine, Health and Human Sciences depending on skills, experience and desired committment.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST PROCESS

Eligible persons intending to submit an Expression of Interest should do so by midnight on Wednesday 25 September attention to Clinical Director, General and Perioperative Medicine, Dr Akshay Athavale at
